## Introduction –

The time to apply for most scholarships is the summer and fall of the senior year.

But the best time to become a COMPETITIVE applicant for scholarships (and other opportunities) starts in the freshman year, and is definitely still in play the sophomore year.

If students are not aware of this trajectory, it can limit the opportunities they could be eligible for their senior year.
